

Making WinPE USB Disk SOP


- 1. Prepare a USB drive with a minimum capacity of 4GB and a maximum capacity of 32GB.
- 2. Open File Explore. Right-click your USB Drive then select Format.



3. In the File System, select FAT32 (Default), then press Start.




4. Unzip WinPE_USBDisk.zip and copy all files into your USB drive root folder.



- Plug your USB Drive into a USB port.
- Hold the ESC key, then press the power button to enter Boot Menu. Select your USB drive and press the Enter key to boot.




7. If your Drive C has been locked by BitLocker, you need to enter the BitLocker Recovery key to unlock BitLocker temporarily.

8. If you enter the correct BitLocker Recovery key or there is no BitLocker, wait for the process to finish and it will show a PASS result.



9. Remove your USB Drive then press any key to continue and reboot the system automatically.
